On June 3, 2021 Premiere Career College signed and submitted to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution intends to use no less than 100 percent of the funds received under the ARP (a)(4) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Premiere Career College has received, as of June 10, 2021, \$194,915.00 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

As of September 30, 2021, Premiere Career College has distributed \$194,915.00 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

At the time of disbursement, there were 144 students at the institution that were eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(4) program.

As of September 30, 2021, 144 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under the ARP (a)(4) program.

The entire eligible student population was awarded a grant. Grant amounts were prioritized based on need using the following table:
